MCUEFNC Social Media Policy

Purpose

Electronic communication is essential for sharing club news and updates with our players, members, and families. All communication will be:

- Timely, relevant, and related to club business.
- Designed to protect privacy, maintain clear boundaries, and prevent bullying or harassment.

MCUEFNC Responsibilities

1. Content Standards

- All social media postings, blogs, status updates, and tweets are considered public comments.
- o Posts (written, photos, or videos) must:
 - Be family-friendly and showcase positive club news and events.
 - Avoid sharing personal information about players, members, or their families.
 - Refrain from misleading, false, or reputation-damaging statements.
 - Not bring the club into disrepute.

2. Zero Tolerance

Abusive, discriminatory, intimidating, or offensive statements will not be tolerated. Offending
posts will be removed, and those responsible will be blocked.

3. Privacy Rules

- o Photos or videos of players will not be published without:
 - The player's permission.
 - Parental permission if the player is under 18 (this consent is obtained during registration).
- Coaches and others working with children and young people must direct communication,
 when appropriate, through parents or guardians.

4. Monitoring

 All club platforms will be regularly reviewed to identify and address misuse or inappropriate content.

Member, Player, and Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

1. Appropriate Usage

- Communication should:
 - Be limited to club-related matters.

- Not offend, intimidate, humiliate, or bully anyone.
- Avoid misleading or defamatory statements.
- Respect the privacy of others.
- Maintain the club's reputation.

2. Respectful Conduct

 Players, members, and parents/guardians must not use social media to voice frustrations about the club, teams, coaches, or other members. Concerns should be directed to the Committee via email at mcuecommittee@gmail.com

Non-Compliance

- 1. Members, players, or parents/guardians who violate this policy may face disciplinary action.
- 2. Cyberbullying (eg. using email, chat rooms, messaging, or social media to harass) may constitute a criminal offence and could be reported to the police.
